ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE TWENTY-FOURTH REGULAR SESSION
AND ALLOCATION OF THE AGENDA ITEMS

Fifth report of the General Committee

1. At its 185th meeting, held on 11 November 1969, the General Committee considered a request presented by Algeria, Bulgaria, the Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Cambodia, Congo (Brazzaville), Cuba, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Mali, Mongolia, Poland, Romania, Southern Yemen, Sudan, Syria, the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and Yemen (A/7658), for the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-fourth session of an additional item entitled "Need to put an end to the discussion in the United Nations on the unification of Korea".^{1/}
2. In the course of the meeting, the United States representative proposed that, if inclusion of the item in the agenda was recommended, the General Committee should decide to recommend that it should become sub-item (d) of item 99 (Question of Korea), that it should be referred to the First Committee and that it should be considered by that Committee when it took up the other sub-items of item 99.
3. The General Committee took the following decisions concerning the proposals before it:
 - (a) By 8 votes to 4, with 12 abstentions, it decided to recommend that the item entitled "Need to put an end to the discussion in the United Nations on the unification of Korea" should be included in the agenda.

- (b) By 14 votes to 3, with 6 abstentions, it adopted the United States proposal referred to in paragraph 2 above. Consequently, agenda item 99 would read as follows:

"Question of Korea:

- (a) Withdrawal of United States and all other foreign forces occupying South Korea under the flag of the United Nations;
- (b) Missiolution of the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea;
- (c) Report of the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea;
- (d) Need to put an end to the discussion in the United Nations on the unification of Korea".
