APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS

Note by the Secretary-General

1. By resolution 1792 (XVII) of 11 December 1962, the General Assembly appointed three persons for three-year terms, beginning on 1 January 1963, to fill the vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Contributions which had been indicated in the Secretary-General's Note in document A/5156.
2. Subsequently, a new vacancy has arisen as a result of the resignation, effective 1 January 1963, of Mr. C.S. Jha. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, one person to serve the unexpired portion of his term of office. Since Mr. Jha was appointed at the fifteenth session for a three-year term to commence on 1 January 1961, the person elected in his place would serve from 1 January to 31 December 1963.
