APPLICATION OF UGANDA FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP
IN THE UNITED NATIONSCables dated 9 October 1962 from the Prime Minister
of Uganda addressed to the Secretary-General

Note by the Secretary-General: Pursuant to rule 136 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit herewith, for the information of the Members of the United Nations, copies of cables addressed to him on 9 October 1962 by the Prime Minister of Uganda with regard to the application of Uganda for admission to membership in the United Nations.

ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT OF UGANDA AND IN MY CAPACITY AS PRIME MINISTER, I HAVE THE HONOUR TO INFORM YOU THAT UGANDA BEING TODAY INDEPENDENT WISHES HEREBY TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE UNITED NATIONS WITH ALL THE RIGHTS AND DUTIES ATTACHED THERETO. I SHOULD ACCORDINGLY BE GRATEFUL IF THIS APPLICATION COULD BE SUBMITTED TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL AT ITS NEXT MEETING. FOR THIS PURPOSE I AM SENDING BY SEPARATE TELEGRAM A DECLARATION MADE IN PURSUANCE OF RULE 58 OF THE COUNCIL'S RULES OF PROCEDURE. A FORMAL INSTRUMENT WILL FOLLOW IN DUE COURSE.

DECLARATION

IN CONNEXION WITH THE APPLICATION BY UGANDA FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE UNITED NATIONS FORWARDED THIS DAY, I HAVE THE HONOUR, ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT OF UGANDA AND IN MY CAPACITY AS PRIME MINISTER, TO DECLARE THAT UGANDA ACCEPTS IN FULL OBLIGATIONS CONTAINED IN THE CHARTER OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND SOLEMNLY UNDERTAKES TO FULFIL THEM.
