DIPLOMATIC MISSIONS UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC AND GHANA HAVE BEEN SUBJECTED TO  
ARBITRARY MEASURES EXPULSION TERRITORY CONGO STOP GOVERNMENT REPUBLIC GUINEA  
INDIGNANT AT THESE MEASURES WHICH ARE ILLEGAL AND CONTRARY INTERNATIONAL LAW  
AND SPIRIT UNITED NATIONS CHARTER AND PROTESTS AGAINST UNPARDONABLE INDIFFERENCE  
REPRESENTATIVES UNITED NATIONS ORGANIZATION CONGO STOP WE URGE UNITED NATIONS  
REINSTATE MISSIONS THUS FLOUTED AND PREVENT RECURRENCE SIMILAR ILLEGALITY.

PEOPLE AND GOVERNMENT REPUBLIC GUINEA DEEPLY INCENSED BY THE HUMILIATIONS OF  
WHICH PRESIDENT LUMUMBA IS VICTIM AT HANDS OF ARMED BANDS MOBUTU AND CONVEY TO  
YOU THEIR COMPLETE MISGIVINGS IN VIEW ATTITUDE REPRESENTATIVES UNITED NATIONS  
ORGANIZATION CONGO OPENLY UPHOLDING ILLEGAL AND ARBITRARY ACTIONS STOP IN VIEW  
OF THIS SITUATION REPUBLIC GUINEA HENCEFORTH RESERVES ALL RIGHTS TO SEEK OTHER  
MEANS WITHIN PURELY AFRICAN FRAMEWORK TO SUPPORT CONGOLESE PEOPLE IN STRUGGLE  
AGAINST ALL FORMS COLONIALISM.
