RESTORATION OF THE LAWFUL RIGHTS OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC
OF CHINA IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 8 December 1964 from the Acting Permanent Representative
of Ghana to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Upon instruction from my Government I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the Republic of Ghana has decided to associate itself with the request by the Royal Government of Cambodia, contained in the letter of 20 October 1964 and circulated as document A/5761 dated 20 October 1964, for the inclusion in the agenda of the nineteenth regular session of the United Nations General Assembly of the item entitled "Restoration of the lawful rights of the People's Republic of China in the United Nations". I therefore have the honour to request you to consider Ghana as co-sponsor of the above-mentioned request.
