APPLICATION OF MALAWI FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP
IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 6 August 1964 from the Minister of External Affairs
of Malawi to the Secretary-General

Note by the Secretary-General: Pursuant to rule 136 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit herewith, for the information of the Members of the United Nations, a copy of a letter dated 6 August 1964 from the Minister of External Affairs of Malawi concerning the admission of Malawi to membership in the United Nations.

On behalf of the Government of Malawi and in my capacity as Minister of External Affairs, I have the honour to inform you that Malawi, having attained independence on 6 July 1964, wishes herewith to make application for membership of the United Nations with all the rights and duties attached thereto.

I would accordingly be grateful if this application could be submitted to the Security Council at its next meeting. For this purpose I attach a declaration made in pursuance of rule 58 of the Council's rules of procedure and signed by the Prime Minister of Malawi.
