Report of the Secretary-General

1. The present report is submitted to the General Assembly in pursuance of resolution 257 A (III) of 3 December 1948, which requested the Secretary-General to "submit, at each regular session of the General Assembly, a report on the credentials of the permanent representatives accredited to the United Nations".
2. All Member States have set up permanent missions at the seat of the United Nations, with the exception of Gambia.
3. At the date of the present report, the following Member States have appointed permanent representatives and transmitted to the Secretary-General credentials for those representatives in accordance with paragraph 1 of the above-mentioned resolution:
