



Twentieth sessionREPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON ARRANGEMENTS FOR A CONFERENCE
FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVIEWING THE CHARTER*

1. By resolution 1993 (XVIII) of 17 December 1963 the General Assembly decided to keep in being the Committee on arrangements for a conference for the purpose of reviewing the Charter and to invite the Committee to report with recommendations to the General Assembly at its twentieth session. It further requested the continuation of the work envisaged in paragraph 4 of General Assembly resolution 992 (X), namely, the preparation and publication of the Supplements to the Repertory of Practice of United Nations Organs.
2. The Committee met on 16 September 1965 under the chairmanship of Mr. Abdul Rahman Pazhwak (Afghanistan). It elected Mr. José Luis Redondo (Costa Rica) as Vice-Chairman to fill the vacancy left by Mr. Fernando Volio Jiménez (Costa Rica) and Mr. Kurt Waldheim (Austria) as Rapporteur to fill the vacancy left by Mr. Franz Matsch (Austria).
3. In opening the discussion the Chairman referred to the decision taken by the General Assembly in 1955 to establish the Committee and reviewed briefly the work done by the Committee at its previous sessions. He expressed satisfaction in regard to the ratification by an overwhelming majority of Member States of the amendments to increase the membership of the Security Council and the Economic and Social Council.
4. The Rapporteur introduced a draft resolution which would keep the Committee in being and invite it to report with recommendations to the General Assembly at the twenty-second session. It would also request the Committee to continue the preparation of Supplements to the Repertory. After statements were made by the

representatives of the USSR and the United States, the Committee adopted the draft resolution by 54 votes to none, with 10 abstentions.

5. The Committee therefore recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

The General Assembly,

Recalling the provisions of its resolutions 992 (X) of 21 November 1955, 1136 (XII) of 14 October 1957, 1381 (XIV) of 20 November 1959, 1670 (XVI) of 15 December 1961, 1756 (XVII) of 23 October 1962 and 1993 (XVIII) of 17 December 1963 relating to the establishment, under Article 109 of the Charter, of the Committee on arrangements for a conference for the purpose of reviewing the Charter and the functions entrusted to the Committee,

1. Decides to keep in being the Committee on arrangements for a conference for the purpose of reviewing the Charter and invites the Committee to report with recommendations to the General Assembly at its twenty-second session;

2. Requests that the work envisaged in paragraph 4 of General Assembly resolution 992 (X) should be continued.
