QUESTION OF KOREA*

Letter dated 5 August 1966 from the Chargé d'Affaires a.i. of Chile to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to address myself to you in connexion with Chile's participation in the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea.

In respect of this matter, aware of the Commission's responsibilities and the importance of its work, considering the enormous difficulty which this presents to Chile, both from a budgetary viewpoint and from the viewpoint of the shortage of staff in Chile's missions in the Far East, and taking account of the fact that, as you are aware, Chile has participated in the said Commission for many years, my Government has instructed me to communicate to you its decision to withdraw from the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea.

I therefore request you to transmit this decision of the Government of Chile to the General Assembly at its twenty-first regular session in order that it may take such steps as it deems necessary.
