THE TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

WITHDRAWAL OF UNITED STATES AND ALL OTHER FOREIGN FORCES OCCUPYING
SOUTH KOREA UNDER THE FLAG OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 17 August 1967 from the Permanent Representative of
Romania to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

In the light of the well-known position of the Government of the Socialist Republic of Romania, which has been consistently declaring for the dismantling of foreign military bases and the withdrawal of all the troops from the territory of other States within their national frontiers, as well as of its position on the question of the withdrawal of the United States and of all the foreign forces stationed in South Korea under the flag of the United Nations, which has been expressed in the previous debate of the General Assembly on that matter, I have the honour to inform you that Romania supports the request for inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-second session of the General Assembly of the United Nations of the item entitled "Withdrawal of United States and all other foreign forces occupying South Korea under the flag of the United Nations".

I should be grateful if you would take the necessary steps to circulate this letter as an official document of the General Assembly.
