Note verbale dated 25 July 1967 from the Permanent Mission of Poland
to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of the Polish People's Republic to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to his note No. PO 230 PAI (4-1) of 10 July 1967 has the honour to inform him as follows:

The Government of the Polish People's Republic being aware of the plight of the victims of Israel aggression has decided to render its immediate assistance to the population of Jordan, Syria and the United Arab Republic, suffering as the result of Israel's military assault.

It is of course the contention of the Government of the Polish People's Republic that the responsibility for all damages and tragic consequences of the aggression against Arab States should be borne entirely by Israel.

Guided however by the anxiousness to alleviate the immense suffering of the Arab population victimized by war, the Polish Government has contributed a sum of 430 million zloties in kind.

In accordance with this decision, medicine, food, blankets, clothing and household articles are being dispatched directly to Jordan for a sum of about 120 million zloties, to Syria for about 120 million zloties and to the United Arab Republic for about 190 million zloties.

The Permanent Mission of Poland should be grateful if the Secretary-General would have this note circulated as a document of the General Assembly.
