APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF

Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Ernesto C. GARRIDO (Philippines)

1. At its 1622nd meeting, on 10 December 1973, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/9102) concerning the vacancies which will occur in the membership of the Committee on Contributions as a result of the expiration on 31 December 1973 of the terms of office of three of its members.
2. The members of the Fifth Committee had been invited to suggest the names of persons who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to the Committee on Contributions in accordance with the provisions of rules 160 and 161 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly. Three names were submitted for the consideration of the Committee (A/C.5/1575).
3. The Fifth Committee voted by secret ballot to decide on its recommendations to the General Assembly. The result of the voting was as follows:

Five other persons received a total of nine votes.

4. Mr. Naito (Japan), Mr. Hennes (United States of America) and Mr. Tardos (Hungary), having received the required majority, were declared recommended for appointment as members of the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1974.
