Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 1622nd meeting, on 10 December 1973, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/9104) in which he informed the General Assembly of the appointment, after consultation with the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions and subject to the Assembly's confirmation, of the following persons as members of the Investments Committee for a three-year term beginning 1 January 1974:

Mr. George A. Murphy,

Mr. B. K. Nehru.

2. The Fifth Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that it should confirm the appointments made by the Secretary-General.

3. The Fifth Committee also decided to recommend that the General Assembly should take note of the arrangements proposed by the Secretary-General in paragraph 3 of his note (A/9104).

4. One delegation questioned the procedure followed for appointing members of the Investments Committee, as well as the method used for choosing the adviser referred to in paragraph 3 of the Secretary-General's note (A/9104).
