Letter dated 14 June 1974 from the President of the General Assembly
to the Secretary-General

In connexion with my letter of 6 June 1974 (A/9558), I have the honour to inform you that, having received from the regional group concerned the last candidacy needed to complete the membership of the Ad Hoc Committee on the Special Programme, I have appointed Czechoslovakia as the thirty-sixth member of the Ad Hoc Committee.

Consequently, the Committee will be composed of the following members:

Algeria, Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Chad, Costa Rica, Czechoslovakia, France, Germany (Federal Republic of), Guyana, India, Iran, Japan, Kuwait, Madagascar, Nepal, Netherlands, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Paraguay, Philippines, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Swaziland, Syrian Arab Republic, Turkey, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Upper Volta, Uruguay, Venezuela, Yugoslavia and Zaire.
