Confirmation of the appointment of the Secretary-General of the  
United Nations Conference on Trade and Development

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Section II, paragraph 27, of General Assembly resolution 1995 (XIX) of 30 December 1964 provides that the Secretariat of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development "shall be headed by the Secretary-General of the Conference, who shall be appointed by the Secretary-General of the United Nations and confirmed by the General Assembly".
2. At its 2115th plenary meeting, on 19 December 1972, the General Assembly confirmed the reappointment by the Secretary-General of Mr. Manuel Pérez Guerrero as Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development for a one-year term beginning on 1 April 1973 and ending on 31 March 1974.
3. In accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned resolution, the Secretary-General has decided to appoint Mr. Gamani Corea as Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development for a term of office of three years beginning on 1 April 1974 and ending on 31 March 1977. In this connexion, the Secretary-General wishes to state that this appointment is being made after consultation with Mr. Gamani Corea. The Secretary-General expresses the hope that the General Assembly will confirm this appointment.
