ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY CO-ORDINATION OF THE
UNITED NATIONS WITH THE SPECIALIZED AGENCIES AND

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Ernesto C. GARRIDO (Philippines)

1. At its 2123rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 1973, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include this item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. At the 1613th meeting of the Fifth Committee, on 29 November 1973, the Chairman of the Committee made a statement regarding the organization of work, in which he referred, inter alia, to this item. He indicated that the main report to be considered was that of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions and that, in view of its other commitments and very heavy workload, that Committee's report to the General Assembly at its current session would be confined to summaries of the budgets of the agencies and would not deal with general co-ordination matters. In the circumstances, he proposed that consideration of the item should be deferred to the twenty-ninth session of the General Assembly. In the ensuing discussion, general acceptance of the Chairman's proposal was expressed.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should defer consideration of the item entitled "Administrative and budgetary co-ordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency" until its twenty-ninth session.
