PATTERN OF CONFERENCES

Note by the Secretary-General

1. At its 1501st plenary meeting, on 20 December 1966, the General Assembly adopted resolution 2239 (XXI) entitled "Pattern of conferences". Under that resolution the General Assembly established a Committee on Conferences consisting of fifteen members to be designated by the President of the Assembly for a period of three years.
2. The Secretary-General has been informed by the President of the twenty-first session of the General Assembly that he has designated the following Member States, under operative paragraph 3 of the above-mentioned resolution, to serve on the Committee on Conferences: Algeria, Burma, Congo (Democratic Republic of), Czechoslovakia, France, India, Jamaica, Japan, New Zealand, Spain, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Venezuela and Zambia.
