Letter dated 19 December 1966 from the Permanent Representative of
Cambodia to the United Nations addressed to the President of the
General Assembly

I have the honour to request you to consider Cambodia as one of the countries which abstained in the vote on the report of the Credentials Committee for the twenty-first session of the General Assembly.

The Cambodian delegation continues to refuse to recognize the "credentials" of a group of individuals who, thanks to the support of the United States of America, illegally occupies the seat of China in the United Nations and in all of its organs. For Cambodia the only legitimate representatives of China and the Chinese people are those of the Government of the People's Republic of China.

I request you to have this letter issued as an official document of the General Assembly.
