DECENTRALIZATION OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES  
OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Second Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Georg REISCH (Austria)

1. The General Assembly, at its 1415th plenary meeting, on 24 September 1966, allocated to the Second Committee agenda item 43 entitled "Decentralization of the economic and social activities of the United Nations".
2. The Committee considered this item at its 1065th to 1069th meetings, held between 10 and 14 November 1966.
3. In considering this item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/6429), a report of the Secretary-General on the decentralization of the economic and social activities and strengthening of the regional economic commissions and the United Nations Office in Beirut (E/4075 and Corr.1), the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/6114) and the report of the Economic and Social Council to the General Assembly at its twentieth session.<sup>1/</sup>

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SECOND COMMITTEE

4. At its 1069th meeting, the Second Committee unanimously decided to recommend to the General Assembly the adoption of the following decision:

"The General Assembly took note of the report of the Secretary-General on the decentralization of the economic and social activities and strengthening of the regional economic commissions and the United Nations Office in Beirut (E/4075 and Corr.1)."
