Financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by  
the Fourth Committee (A/C.4/L.859)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 1171st meeting on 16 December 1966, the Fifth Committee considered the statement of financial implications submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/1109) of the recommendation of the Fourth Committee (A/C.4/L.859) concerning the above question. The Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions presented the report of that Committee orally.
2. The Fifth Committee decided to inform the General Assembly that the costs of the proposed United Nations presence in the Territory could not at this time be determined. The Committee therefore recommends that, should the proposal be adopted, the General Assembly authorize the Secretary-General to meet, with the prior concurrence of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, any necessary expenditures for this purpose initially under the terms of the resolution relating to unforeseen and extraordinary expenses in 1967.
