APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUBSIDIARY  
BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

UNITED NATIONS STAFF PENSION COMMITTEE

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Gregor WOSCHNAGG (Austria)

1. At its 1339th meeting, held on 2 December 1969, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/1267) announcing the resignation, effective 31 December 1969, of Mr. Wilbur H. Ziehl as a member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee.
2. The members of the Fifth Committee had been invited to submit the name of a person who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to the United Nations Staff Pension Committee, in accordance with the provisions of article XXI of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund. Mr. Albert F. Bender, Jr., was proposed for election to fill the vacancy caused by Mr. Ziehl's resignation.
3. The Committee voted by secret ballot to decide on its recommendation.  
The result of the voting was as follows:

<u>Number of ballot papers:</u>	85
<u>Invalid ballots:</u>	1
<u>Number of valid ballots:</u>	84
<u>Abstentions:</u>	3
<u>Number of members voting:</u>	81
<u>Required majority:</u>	41

Number of votes obtained:

Mr. Albert F. Bender, Jr. . . . . 73

Eight votes were cast for three other persons.

4. Mr. Bender (United States of America), having received the required majority, was declared recommended for appointment as a member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee for the unexpired portion of Mr. Ziehl's term of office, that is, from 1 January 1970 to 31 December 1970.

5. The Fifth Committee therefore recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:
