Addendum

Further replies have been received from Governments giving their views on the holding of a special meeting of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization, as follows:

(1) Governments fully supporting the holding of a special meeting

Zambia welcomes the idea of convening the special meeting but regrets that no representatives from Zambia will be in attendance.

(2) Governments prepared to support the holding of a special meeting under certain conditions

AUSTRIA

Austria is in principle agreeable to calling the meeting but is hesitant about the most appropriate date. It considers that UNIDO could gain more knowledge about the ways and means which would respond best to the needs of the developing countries. It seems doubtful whether the necessary preparation could be carried out in view of the envisaged date. Clarification of the function of the meeting in relation to the responsibilities of the UNIDO Board and the Preparatory Committee for the Second Development Decade is highly desirable. This delineation of functions could best be done at the fourth meeting of the Board.
