and Budgetary Questions

1. The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered a report by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/484) submitting estimates in respect of the financial year 1952 for the Commission appointed by the General Assembly under its resolution adopted on 20 December 1951 (A/L.12).
2. In reporting, under rule 152 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, on the financial implications of the relevant resolution proposed by the Ad Hoc Political Committee (A/2020), the Fifth Committee indicated (A/2021) that the necessary budgetary provision for 1952 would amount to \$45,000.
3. The Advisory Committee concurs in the proposal now submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/484, paragraph 2) to the effect that, in view of the subsequent change in the itinerary of the Commission, the provision in the 1952 budget should be limited to \$17,100, and that additional requirements, if any, for the Commission should be financed by means of an advance from the Working Capital Fund, as constituting a commitment relating to the maintenance of peace and security. Accordingly, the Advisory Committee recommends for approval the provision of \$17,100 under section 1, chapter VIII, of the 1952 budget, together with a corresponding reduction in the appropriation provisionally approved for section 33 (Investigations, Inquiries and other activities).
