REQUEST THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO PLACE ON THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA OF THE FIFTH  
SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AN ITEM: "FAILURE OF THE UNION OF SOVIET  
SOCIALIST REPUBLICS TO REPATRIATE OR OTHERWISE ACCOUNT FOR PRISONERS OF WAR  
DETAINED IN SOVIET TERRITORY". AN EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM WILL FOLLOW.
