



LAWS AND REGULATIONS

THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT, 1974

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HEALTH
UNDER SECTION 35 OF THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT, 1974 1/

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs, (Prescription Form) Regulations 1981.
2. (1) No authorised person shall prescribe a dangerous drug otherwise than on a prescription form as set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The prescription form shall be in triplicate.

(3) Each copy shall be of a different colour.

(4) One prescription form shall be used for each dangerous drug prescribed.
5. (5) (a) Every prescription form shall bear a printed serial number

(b) Where a prescription form is issued by a veterinary surgeon the serial number shall be preceded by the letters "V.S"

3. The original and duplicate of the prescription form shall be handed over

(a) to the patient; or

(b) where it is issued by a veterinary surgeon for animal treatment to the person having responsibility for the animal.

4. The supplier shall retain the original and shall forward the duplicate to the Permanent Secretary within seven days.
