The Permanent Mission of the People's Republic of Bangladesh to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Executive Office of the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to forward herewith, in its capacity as Chair of the Governing Council of the Inter-Parliamentary Union, the text (in English and French) of the following resolutions adopted unanimously by the 135th Assembly of the Inter-Parliamentary Union, held in Geneva from 23 to 27 October 2016:

The war and the severe humanitarian situation in Syria, particularly in Aleppo: under agenda items 69 and 34;<sup>1</sup>

Outcome document of the general debate on human rights abuses as precursors of conflict: parliaments as early responders: under agenda items 68 and 61;<sup>2</sup>
