Statement by the Chairman

1. The CHAIRMAN thanked the members of the Committee for the honour they had done him and his country in electing him Chairman of the Committee. He paid a tribute to Mrs. Marico for the devotion and competence with which she had directed the Committee's work at the twenty-ninth session, and expressed his confidence in all those members of the Secretariat with whom he intended

to work closely during the current session. He welcomed the delegations of the new Members of the Organization: the Republic of Cape Verde, the Democratic Republic of Sao Tome and Principe and the People's Republic of Mozambique, which were joining the Committee for the first time, and expressed the hope that the work of the Committee would make a vital contribution to the development of genuine international understanding and co-operation.
