I am writing to you at this eleventh hour of the Palauans' struggle to prevent the United States from establishing military bases in their island home. I am a United States citizen, but so much of the imperialistic strategies it uses in the name of freedom I cannot condone.

I will not allow myself to fall into this condition, for I want to imbue my brothers and sisters with hope, supporting them in the upholding of their anti-nuclear Constitution.
