LETTER DATED 7 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE ACTING MINISTER FOR FOREIGN
AFFAIRS OF CYPRUS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your telex message by which you communicated to my Government the text of resolution 661 (1990) adopted by the Security Council at its meeting on 6 August 1990.

I hereby wish to inform Your Excellency that the Government of the Republic of Cyprus supports the above resolution and will fully abide by its provisions.

All appropriate measures have been, are being or will be taken in order to ensure its full implementation. Cyprus, being itself a victim of foreign aggression, invasion and occupation has always supported and implemented, as a matter of principle, all binding United Nations Security Council resolutions. As you know the Council's resolutions regarding Cyprus remain unimplemented for more than sixteen years and I once more call for their implementation.

I also reiterate on this occasion that the Government of the Republic of Cyprus recognizes as the only legitimate Government of Kuwait the one headed by His Highness the Emir of Kuwait, Sheikh Jaber Al Ahmed Al Sabah.
