**NOTE VERBALE DATED 16 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF LUXEMBOURG TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Representative of Luxembourg to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to his letter No. SCPC/7/90(1) of 8 August 1990, has the honour to inform him of the following legal measures which Luxembourg has enacted under a grand-ducal regulation of 6 August 1990:

Residents of Luxembourg shall not undertake any repayment, assignment or transfer of assets held by them and owned, directly or indirectly, by the State of Kuwait or residents of Kuwait, or by the State of Iraq or residents of Iraq, without prior authorization from the Minister of the Treasury.

All imports originating in, and all exports to, Iraq or Kuwait shall be subject to licencing by the Minister for Foreign Affairs.

Any technical and scientific co-operation and any provision of services for the benefit of residents of Iraq or Kuwait shall be prohibited without prior authorization from the Minister for Foreign Affairs.

The above regulation entered into force on the date of its publication.
