**NOTE VERBALE DATED 29 AUGUST 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF MONGOLIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Representative of the Mongolian People's Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to his note SCPC/7/90(1) of 8 August 1990 concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 661 (1990), has the honour, on instructions of his Government, to convey to him that the Mongolian People's Republic maintains no relations in economic or military fields with Iraq and Kuwait and will not enter with those States into relations of any kind which might run counter to the provisions of the above-mentioned resolution as far as their implementation is called for.

The Government of the Mongolian People's Republic supports United Nations actions to implement the resolutions on the Gulf crisis in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations through peaceful means.
