The Permanent Observer of the Republic of Korea to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with **reference** to the latter's note **SCPC/7/90 (1)** dated A August 1990, has the honour to enclose herewith the memorandum of 20 August 1990 by the Ministry of Foreign **Affairs** on supplementary **measures**, further to the **decisions** taken on Q August 1990 and circulated as Security Council document **S/21487**, to implement United Nations Security Council resolution 661 (1990) on the Iraqi **invasion** of Kuwait,

Memorandum dated 20 August 1990 from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea on measures taken by the Government of the Republic of Korea to implement Security Council resolution 661 (1990)

Further to the **decisions** taken on Q August 1990 and circulated as document S/21487, the **Government** of the Republic of Korea has taken the **following** supplementary measures with immediate effect.

1. Suspension of issuance of the Import License for all commodities and products originating in Iraq and Kuwait:

The **Government** of the Republic of **Korea** has **issued** special guidelines to **suspend issuance** of the Import License for all **commodities and products** originating in Iraq and Kuwait,

The **special** guideliner issued in accordance with the **provisions** of the Foreign Trade Act (hereinafter "**the Act**"), are to prohibit the import of all **goods**, including crude oil, produced in or shipped from Iraq and Kuwait .

2. Suspension of issuance of the Export License for all commodities and products to Iraq and Kuwait:

The Government of the Republic of Korea announced, based on the Act, **special** guidelines to suspend **issuance** of the Export **License** for the sale or supply by Korean nationals or Korean flag vessels of all commodities and products to any party in Iraq and Kuwait)

The Ministry of **Commerce** may approve issuance of the Export License only for the export of **items** designated for medical and **humanitarian** purposes.

3. Suspension of the procurement of construction contracts in Iraq and Kuwait!

On 2 August, the Government of the Republic of Koroa issued, based **on relevant** ordinance, administrative guidelines prohibiting the procurement of construction contracts in Iraq and **Kuwait;**

The **inter-ministerial** meeting held on Q August confirmed the administrative guidelines.

4. Protection of assets of the legitimate Government of Kuwait.1

As **previously** announced by the Government of the **Republic** of Korea in document S/21487, it **has** been confirmed that there **exist** no such **assets** in the Republic of Korea.

5. Penal provisions:

Any person who violates the special administrative guidelines set out above shall, in the absence of stricter penalties under other laws, be subject to the penalties under article 67 of the Act.

6. The special inter-ministerial task force monitoring implementation of the measures taken by the Government of the Republic of *Korea* in pursuance of the resolution 661 (1990) has not found, since its • rtablrhment on Q August, any violation of the above-mentioned special administrative guidelinea by poraons or bodies under the jurisdiction of the Government of the Republic of Koroa.
