NOTE VERBALE DATED 4 SEPTEMBER 1990 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE SUDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Chargé d'affaires of the Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Sudan to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note SCPC/7/90(1) of 8 August 1990 concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 661 (1990), has the honour, on the instructions of his Government, to convey that the Sudan supports Security Council resolution 661 (1990) of 6 August 1990 and will take all possible steps to comply with the provisions of the resolution.

However, as the Sudan will be adversely affected as a result of its application of the resolution by confronting special economic problems, the Government of the Sudan, in accordance with Article 50 of the Charter of the United Nations, would like to consult the Security Council in due course with regard to a solution of these consequential problems.

The Chargé d'affaires would appreciate it if His Excellency's report on the implementation of Security Council resolution 661 (1990) would reflect the intention of the Sudan to request consultations with the Security Council.
