NOTE VERBALE DATED 4 SEPTEMBER 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT  
REPRESENTATIVE OF BANGLADESH TO THE UNITED NATIONS  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Bangladesh to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to resolution 661 (1990) of the Security Council, has the honour to inform as follows:

Bangladesh is enforcing the provisions of the resolution in letter and spirit. As mandated by the resolution, the Government has taken prompt measures to terminate commercial, economic and other relations in public and private sectors between Bangladesh on the one hand and Iraq and Kuwait on the other. Earlier Bangladesh had close ties with Iraq and Kuwait in such major areas as trade, manpower, aviation, investment, shipping and banking. Following the adoption of resolution 661 (1990), all such activities have been frozen. Actions at national level aim at total enforcement of sanctions envisaged by the resolutions. The Government of Bangladesh is also engaged in initiating the necessary amendments/modifications of relevant statutory rules and regulations so as to provide legal coverage to the aforementioned enforcement measures.
