NOTE VERBALE DATED 20 SEPTEMBER 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF  
TURKEY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Turkey to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and further to its notes of 14 and 20 August 1990 regarding the implementation of Security Council resolution 661 (1990) and with reference to Security Council resolution 666 (1990) has the honour to inform him of measures taken by Turkey in connection with the transit to Iraq and Kuwait of foodstuffs and supplies intended strictly for medical purposes:

1. The transit or trans-shipment of foodstuffs to Iraq and Kuwait through Turkey shall not, as before, be permitted as long as the Security Council has not determined that humanitarian circumstances have arisen.
2. The Turkish Red Crescent Society shall be the competent authority in dealing with the transit or trans-shipment of foodstuffs by third countries through Turkey, when the Security Council has determined that humanitarian circumstances have arisen.
3. The Turkish Red Crescent Society shall also be the competent authority in dealing with the transit or trans-shipment through Turkey of supplies intended strictly for medical purposes by third countries.
4. In all cases permission of the Prime Ministry shall be necessary.
