## Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 82nd meeting, on  $1^4$  December 1979, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/34/91) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 11 of its report (A/34/635/Add.3).
- 2. Comments and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/34/SR.82).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to take note of the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/34/91) and to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Second Committee (A/34/635/Add.3, para. 11), no additional appropriations would be required. The related conference-servicing costs would be reflected in the consolidated statement on conference servicing requirement for 1980 to be considered at a later stage during the current session.
