ORGANIZATION OF WORK OF THE SECOND COMMITTEE

Letter dated 11 October 1990 from the Chairman of the Fifth
Committee of the General Assembly to the Chairman of the
Second Committee of the General Assembly on the proposed
medium-term plan for the period 1992-1997

I have the honour to refer to the letter dated 24 September 1990 addressed to me by the President of the General Assembly (A/C.5/45/5), by which he informed me that at the 3rd plenary meeting of the forty-fifth session, held on 21 September 1990, the General Assembly had decided to allocate agenda item 119 (Programme planning), among others, to the Fifth Committee.

By its resolution 36/228 A of 18 December 1981, section I, the General Assembly endorsed the conclusions and recommendations of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination (CPC) on the work of its twenty-first session. ^{1/} One of such recommendations is contained in paragraph 471 of the CPC report, which states that:

"Each chapter of the proposed medium-term plan should be submitted to the appropriate Main Committee of the General Assembly before the plan as a whole is adopted by the General Assembly in plenary meeting."

At its current session, the General Assembly has before it the proposed medium-term plan for the period 1992-1997 (A/45/6), the summary of comments and recommendations made by Member States and intergovernmental bodies since 1988 on the draft introduction to the medium-term plan for the period 1992-1997 (A/45/279), as well as the report of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination on the work of its thirtieth session (A/45/16 (Parts I and II)).

The annex to this letter indicates, for each programme of the proposed plan, the relevant Main Committee(s) to which it should be referred.
