LETTER DATED 27 SEPTEMBER 1990 FROM THE MINISTER FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS OF BOTSWANA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I acknowledge receipt of your communication of 8 August 1990 transmitting the text of resolution 661 (1990), which was adopted by the Security Council at its 2933rd meeting on 6 August 1990.

The Government of Botswana wishes to convey to you the following information on the measures adopted in pursuance of the provisions of the resolution.

- 1. The Government of Botswana is in total support for and compliance with United Nations Security Council resolution 661 (1990). The Government of Botswana also fully subscribes to the other Security Council resolutions (660 (1990), 662 (1990), 664 (1990) and 665 (1990)).
- 2. The Government of Botswana advises, however, that implementing the measures of the resolution will have some adverse economic implications for Botswana. A memorandum outlining these implications will be submitted in due course.
