LETTER DATED 24 NOVEMBER 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE LIBYAN ARAB JAMAHIRIYA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Under Article 28, paragraph 3, of the Charter and the provisions of article 5 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council,

In view of the gravity of the situation in the Gulf, a situation which is liable to explode at any time and to jeopardize international peace and security and thus to involve the full responsibility of the Security Council as the organ entrusted with the maintenance of peace and security, I have the honour to request you, on behalf of the Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, pursuant to the provisions of article 6 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, to ask the Security Council to meet, as a matter of urgency, to consider the serious situation in the Gulf. This meeting should be held in Geneva in order to enable the countries concerned and the greatest possible number of Member States of the United Nations to attend.
