1. At its 31st meeting, on 19 November 1990, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/45/34) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution I recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 15 of its report (A/45/739). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE
