REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON RELATIONS WITH THE HOST COUNTRY

## Report of the Sixth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Saeid MIRZAEE-YENGEJEH (Islamic Republic of Iran)

#### I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. The item entitled "Report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country" was included in the provisional agenda of the forty-fifth session pursuant to General Assembly resolution 44/38 of 4 December 1989.
- 2. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 1990, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Sixth Committee.
- 3. For its consideration of the item, the Sixth Committee had before it the report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country. 1/
- 4. The Sixth Committee considered the item at its 44th and 45th meetings, on 19 and 20 November 1990. The summary records of those meetings contain the views of the representatives who spoke on the item (A/C.6/45/SR.44 and 45).

### II. CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT RESOLUTION A/C.6/45/L.18

5. At its / th meeting, on 19 November 1990, the representative of Cyprus introduced a draft resolution (A/C.6/45/L.18).

6. At the 45th meeting, on 20 November 1990, the Committee adopted draft resolution A/C.6/45/L.18 without a vote (see para. 7).

## III. RECOMMENDATION OF THE SIXTH COMMITTEE

7. The Sixth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country, 2/

Recalling Article 105 of the Charter of the United Nations, the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations 3/ and the Agreement between the United Nations and the United States of America regarding the Headquarters of the United Nations 4/ and the responsibilities of the host country,

Recognizing that effective measures should continue to be taken by the competent authorities of the host country, in particular to prevent any acts violating the security of missions and the safety of their personnel,

Welcoming the increased interest shown by Member States in participating in the work of the Committee,

- 1. Endorses the recommendations and conclusions of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country contained in paragraph 69 of its report;
- 2. Considers that the maintenance of appropriate conditions for the normal work of the delegations and the missions accredited to the United Nations is in the interests of the United Nations and all Member States, and expresses the hope that the host country will continue to take all measures necessary to prevent any interference with the functioning of missions;
- 3. Expresses its appreciation for the efforts made by the host country and hopes that outstanding problems raised at the meetings of the Committee will be duly resolved in a spirit of co-operation and in accordance with international law;

- 4. <u>Urges</u> the host country, in the light of the consideration by the Committee of travel regulations issued by the most country, to continue to bear in mind its obligations to facilitate the functioning of the United Nations and the missions accredited to it;
- 5. Stresses the importance of a positive perception of the work of the United Nations, and urges that efforts be continued to build up public awareness by explaining, through all available means, the importance of the role played by the United Nations and the missions accredited to it in the strengthening of international peace and security;
- 6. Requests the Secretary-General to remain actively engaged in all aspects of the relations of the United Nations with the host country;
- 7. Requests the Committee to continue its work. in conformity with General Assembly resolution 2819 (XXVI) of 15 December 1971;
- 8. Decides to include in the provisional agenda of its forty-sixth session the item entitled "Report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country".
