SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

## Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document \$/21100 of 24 January 1990, \$/21100/Add.2 of 2 February 1990, \$/21100/Add.5 of 16 February 1990, \$/21100/Add.21 of 7 June 1990, \$/21100/Add.30 of 10 August 1990 and \$/21100/Add.37 of 26 October 1990.

During the week ending 10 November 1990, the Security Council took action on the following items:

Central America: efforts towards peace (see S/20370/Add.29, S/20370/Add.44, S/21100/Add.12, S/21100/Add.15, S/21100/Add.17, S/21100/Add.20 and S/21100/Add.22)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 2952nd meeting, held on 5 November 1990, in accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Observer Group in Central America (S/21909) of 26 October 1990.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/21927), which had been prepared in the course of the Council's consultations.

The Security Council then proceeded to vote on the draft resolution (S/21927) and adopted it unanimously as resolution 675 (1990).

Resolution 675 (1990) reads as follows:

## The Security Council.

Recalling its resolutions 637 (1989) of 27 July 1989 and 644 (1989) of 7 November 1989, as well as the statement made by the President of the Security Council on its behalf on 7 November 1989, 1/

- 1. Approves the report of the Secretary-General contained in document S/21909;
- 2. <u>Decides</u> to extend, under its authority, the mandate of the United Nations Observer Group in Central America, as defined in resolution 644 (1989), for a further period of six months, that is until 7 May 1991, bearing in mind the report of the Secretary-General contained in document S/21909 and the need to continue to monitor expenditures carefully during this period of increasing demands on peace-keeping resources;
- 3. Requests the Secretary-General to keep the Security Council fully informed of further developments and to report on all aspects of the operations of the Observer Group before the expiry of the new mandate period.

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 2953rd and 2954th meetings, held on 7 and 9 November 1990.

At the 2953rd meeting, in addition to the representatives invited previously, the President with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Lebanon, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
