AND OTHER APPOINTMENTSAppointment of members of the Committee on ConferencesNote by the Secretary-General

1. By its resolution 43/222 B of 21 December 1988, the General Assembly decided that the Committee on Conferences should be composed of 21 members to be appointed by the President of the Assembly, after consultations with the chairmen of the regional groups, for a period of three years, on the basis of the following geographical distribution:

- (a) Six members from African States;
- (b) Five members from Asian States;
- (c) Four members from Latin American and Caribbean States;
- (d) Two members from Eastern European States;
- (e) Four members from Western European and other States.

The Assembly further decided that one third of the Committee's membership should retire annually and that retiring members would be eligible for reappointment.

3. Since the terms of office of Chile, Cyprus, Egypt, Ethiopia, France, Japan and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics will expire on 31 December 1990, it will be necessary for the General Assembly at its forty-fifth session to appoint seven members to fill the resulting vacancies. The members so appointed will serve for a period of three years beginning on 1 January 1991.
