1. At its 39th meeting, on 30 November 1990, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/45/49) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/45/776). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/45/SR.39).
3. A statement in explanation of position was made by the representative of Japan.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

4. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/45/776).

(a) An additional appropriation of \$28,800 would be required under section 2B (Disarmament affairs activities) of the programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991;
