by the Third Committee in its report (A/45/838, para. 109)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 42nd and 43rd meetings, on 10 and 11 December 1990, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/45/61) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution V recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 109 of its report (A/45/838) on a World Conference on Human Rights. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman. An oral statement was also made by the Chairman of the Committee on Conferences.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/45/SR.42 and 43).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution V recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 109 of its report (A/45/838);

(a) No additional appropriations would be required in 1990-1991;

(b) The estimate for the proposals of the Preparatory Committee and for the Conference in 1992-1993 would be considered by the General Assembly at its forty-sixth session.

4. The Fifth Committee endorsed the comments of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions and concurred in its concern over the tendency of other intergovernmental committees to involve themselves in administrative and budgetary matters that are within the competence of the Fifth Committee.
