- 1. At its 39th meeting, on 30 November 1990, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/45/48) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/45/783). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/45/SR.39).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/45/783), no additional appropriations would be required under sections 2A (Political and Security Council affairs; peace-keeping activities) or 29 (Conference and library services) of the programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991.
