Letter dated 15 November 1985 from the Permanent Representative
of Afghanistan to the United Nations addressed to the
Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that the Chargé d'affaires of the Pakistan Embassy at Kabul was summoned to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan at 11 a.m. on 11 November 1985 and the following was brought to his attention by the Director of the First Political Department:

"The Pakistani authorities, with a view to covering up their aggressive actions and in continuation of their previous baseless and false allegation against the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan, have claimed that the armed

forces of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan have opened fire at the Arando area of the Chitral District.

"The Government of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan, after thoroughly investigating the case, considers this allegation of the Government of Pakistan as void of any reality and, therefore, categorically rejects it. It is further mentioned that the Pakistani authorities must put an end to such accusations which have no other result but further tension in the frontier areas."

I have further the honour to request Your Excellency to arrange for the circulation of this letter as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 72, 73, 131, 132 and 137, and of the Security Council.
