Letter dated 26 December 1979 from the Permanent Observer of the Palestine Liberation Organization to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

As a Christmas gesture of "good-will", Israeli forces of occupation, pursuing the Zionist ideology of racism and suppression, stormed Bir Zeit University on Christmas eve, and viciously attacked the students. The Israeli troops then proceeded to steal whatever they could lay their hands on in the University.

Further, Israeli troops raided the home of Mrs. M. Tarazi, the 83 year-old mother of Mr. Zehdi Terzi, the Permanent Observer of the Palestine Liberation Organization to the United Nations. At the time of the raid Mrs. Tarazi was alone in her home in Jerusalem. When she refused to open the door, the Israeli troops broke down the door and went on a wild rampage of the house. They stole a vacuum-cleaner, a food processor, a typewriter, a tape-recorder, a juice processor, and three sets of liqueur glasses.

Such attacks when considered in their proper perspective are reminiscent of the all too familiar storm-trooper tactics of the Nazi SS, and their message during this holy time of the celebration of the birth of Christ are all too obvious.
