Election of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees

## Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. By its resolution 42/108 of 7 December 1987, the General Assembly decided to continue the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees for a further period of five years from 1 January 1989.
- 2. By its decision 44/312 of 20 November 1989, the General Assembly, on the proposal of the Secretary-General (A/44/748), appointed Mr. Thorvald Stoltenberg as United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1990. On 2 November 1990, the Secretary-General accepted with regret the decision of Mr. Stoltenberg to resign from his post with immediate effect.
- 3. In conformity with the procedure established by paragraph 13 of the statute of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, the Secretary-General proposes to the General Assembly that it elect Mrs. Sadako OGATA (Japan) as United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees for a period of three years beginning on 1 January 1991.
