Programme budget implications of the draft resolution  
contained in paragraph 10 of document A/40/847

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Falk MELTKE (German Democratic Republic)

1. At its 52nd meeting, on 2 December 1985, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/40/34) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended in paragraph 10 of its report (A/40/847). The report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/40/SR.52).

### DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 74 votes to 12, with 9 abstentions to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution contained in paragraph 10 of its report (A/40/847), an additional appropriation of \$108,800 would be required under section 12 of the proposed programme budget for 1986-1987.

Aqainst: Australia, Belgium, Canada, France, Germany, Federal Republic of, Israel, Japan, Netherlands, New Zealand, Portugal, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining: Austria, Denmark, Finland, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Norway, Spain, Sweden.
